## D2 New York In Depth City Tour

In the morning, take ride to Wall Street, photo taken with the Charging Bull, walk along the Wall Street starting at the Trinity Church. Take a harbor cruise\* to see the Statue of Liberty and after landed, take ride to see the 911 memorial & the One World Trade Center. Free time at the Chelsea Market (1 hour), where you can enjoy your lunch as well. After that, the tour guide will bring you to the new develop tourist icon, "The Vessel"; it is a

structure and landmark which was built as part of the Hudson Yards Redevelopment Project in Manhattan. Opened on March 15, 2019 after two years' construction, it is designed by the British designer Thomas Heatherwick, the elaborate honeycomb-like structure rises 16 stories and consists of 154 flights of stairs, 2,500 steps, and 80 landings for visitors to climb. "The Vessel" is the main feature of the Hudson Yards Public Square. its final cost is expected to be \$200 million. China Town will be the last itinerary of the day, of course, dinner can be easily finished at the same time.

### D3 New York -- Washington D.C.

Continue New York City tour, in the morning visiting the United Nation Head Quarter; going through the security check point and arrive the lobby of the building, where the photos for the world special events and the Secretary-General of United Nations are exhibiting. Of course, the exclusive UN postal office should not be missed before leaving the property. Heading west to the center of the city, which is the location of the New York Public Library, one of the five famous libraries in the world. It is a neoclassical style property. The whole building is made of marble, with bronze metal doors, windows and the beautiful decorated dome; the tall vaulted ceiling is hung with quaint and gorgeous chandeliers, which are gorgeous and elegant. Unlike a library, it more likely to be a museum. The beauty and exquisiteness of the New York Public Library has made the famous movies & TV shows, such as "Tiffany's Breakfast", "Spider-Man 2", "The Day After" and "Sex and the City", filmed there. After that, take ride to the Washington DC, you can try the "Five Guys Burgers", where President Obama has also sitting for lunch, before going to hotel.

### D6 Niagara Falls - Boston

Continue the Niagara Falls tour in the morning. Niagara Falls is a comprise of three waterfalls at the southern end of Niagara Gorge, which straddles the international border between Canada and the United States. Located on the Niagara River, which drains Lake Erie into Lake Ontario, the combined falls have the highest flow rate of any waterfall in North America that has a vertical drop of more than 50 meters (160 ft). The world-famous boat tour," Maid of the Mist" \* will bring you directly into the basin of the Horseshoe Falls, the most powerful waterfall, for unrivaled views. After the boat tour, the "Cave of the Wind" \* is another must-to-do thing at Niagara Falls, an elevator takes you down to the level of the Niagara River at the base of the American Falls. A series of redwood decks and platforms allow you to walk right up to the base of the Bridal Veil Falls with water crashing down right on you and flowing beneath the decking. Don't forget to wear the rain gear that been provided. You can finish the lunch at the Hard Rock Café before take ride to Boston, Massachusetts.

Today, its history, influence and academic reputation have made it one of the most prestigious universities in the world. Free walking time at the Copley Square, a landmark of Boston City, famous preparties including Old South Church, Trinity Church, Boston Public Library, John Hancock Tower. A combination of Historic & Modernize buildings that creating a spectacular picture. Freedom trail tour, this one and half hour walking tour, historic attractions including Boston Common, Massachusetts State House, Old Sate House, King's Chapel, Quincy Market etc., will lead you to the source of the revolutionary war in 1774 and the history of the birthplace of America. Boston Duck Tour\* that operates historical tours of the city, conducted on replica DUKWs vehicle, other than the famous attractions on ground, it also running on the Charles River, the beauty of Boston harbor imposing an unforgettable memory. Since in Boston, lobster is another temptation, Legal Seafood Restaurant is a suggestion to have dinner with your love one. After the dinner, transfer to hotel.

## D8 Boston - Rhode Island – Newport Mansions - Yale University – New York

Leaving Boston in the morning and heading south to Rhode Island, visit one of the famous glorious mansions located in Newport of Rhode Island, The Marble House\*. It was built between 1888 and 1892 for Mr. and Mrs. William K. Vanderbilt designed by the architect Richard Morris Hunt. The cost of the house was more than \$11 million, of which \$7 million was spent on 500,000 cubic feet of marble. It was not only the remembrance of the houses of the early 19th century but also a social and architectural landmark that set the pace for Newport's subsequent transformation from a quiet summer colony of wooden & modest houses to the legendary resort of opulent stone palaces. In Newport, you must have walk along the world-famous public access – The Cliff Walk. It combines the natural beauty of the Newport shoreline with the architectural history of Newport's gilded age. Wildflowers, birds, geology ... all add to this delightful walk. Take ride heading further south to The New Haven of Connecticut, visit another famous Ivy League College, The Yale University. The mysterious senior society “Skull & Bones “with prominent alumni such as father & son of former Presidents of America, George Bush; attached many students with outstanding background to study there. Yale is noted for its largely Collegiate Gothic campus as well as several iconic modern buildings; Yale also owns and has restored many noteworthy 19th-century mansions along Hillhouse Avenue, which was considered the most beautiful street in America by Charles Dickens when he visited the United States in the 1840s. In 2011, Travel Leisure listed the Yale campus as one of the most beautiful in the United States. After dinner you will check in hotel at New Jersey.
